













## LADY GOWRIE TAROONA VACATION CARE INFORMATION

### Location:

Taroona Primary School, Channel Highway, Taroona. Located in the school Hall which is off the netball court near car park.

### Opening Hours and Age Range:

8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. We cater for children 4-12 years of age.

### Fees and Charging Practices:

The daily session cost is \$64.00 for children aged 4-12 years. Child Care Benefits and the 50% Rebate are available for eligible families through contacting the Department of Human Services on 136 150. Families will receive an invoice fortnightly through email. The only option for payment is through our Ezidebit system which automatically deducts all monies owing on a set Friday fortnightly from your nominated bank account or credit card. There is a \$10 overdue fee for overdue accounts. A fee will be added to your account for excursions and incursions. A late collection fee of \$20 per 10 minutes or part thereof will be charged for late pickups.

### Cancellations and Bookings:

We will confirm all bookings shortly after by phone or email. Please note that your booking will not be excepted if you have not filled out a 2018 enrolment form. Children cannot attend until you have received written or verbal confirmation from our Head Office. Bookings received after the closing date **1/12/2017** will be considered after all confirmations have been given for booked days. If your child is absent on your booked day, please let the OSHC office know on 6230 6864 or 6230 6806. Normal Absences are charged unless two weeks' notice is provided. Under National Law if your child is absent on the first or last day of a booking Child Care Benefit and the 50% Rebate cannot be provided and therefore full fees will apply.

### Signing Children In and Out:

Children must be signed in and out each day by a Parent/Guardian or authorised person over the age of 18. If your child/ren are absent you will be asked to sign for that day to acknowledge they were absent. This is a legal requirement and stipulation for you to receive your Child Care Benefit entitlements.

### What to Bring:

We provide a nutritious snack for morning tea and afternoon tea each day. The menu is on display at the service. **Families will need to provide a healthy, adequate lunch.** Heating and cooling facilities are not always available so please ensure you cater for this. Foods containing sugary, salty or fatty foods are discouraged. We are an allergy aware service so ensure you don't pack any foods containing nuts. Water is always available at the service, but we recommend you provide a **drink bottle** containing water daily. Please cater for all weather possibilities and provide sensible footwear and clothing. Sun safe policy is in effect, so families will need to provide **sun safe clothing** including a **broad brimmed or legionnaire style hat**. Please note that we do not accept any responsibility for personal belongings children have brought to the service such as electronic devices. We limit the use of electronic items to one hour per day and children must not have internet access on such devices. Children are not to bring money to the service as all excursions costs are catered for.
